Hours of work	35 hours per week, including some Saturday and evening work*
Place of work	Greener Kirkcaldy office, community locations and people's homes throughout South, Central and West Fife; Greener Kirkcaldy has a hybrid working policy, allowing staff to work from a hybrid of office and home depending on the needs of each role
Contract	Permanent, after completion of 3-month probation
Holiday	33 days inclusive of public holidays per annum pro rata initially, going up to 37 days after 5 years' service
Requirement	The post-holder will be subject to a Disclosure Scotland check

Job purpose

You will support people in, or at risk of fuel poverty, by fitting simple energy-efficiency measures in their homes. These measures include putting up curtain poles and thermal curtains, installing radiator reflector panels, draught-proofing, and fitting LED light bulbs. You will arrange and make home visits in order to carry out that work, keep records of work and input data into the database. No database skills necessary - full training will be given.

Your role will also involve carrying out general maintenance of Greener Kirkcaldy's premises, including regular cleaning and handy work, as required.

Specific responsibilities

- To install simple energy efficient measures within the home
- To engage with project participants in a positive and constructive way and ensure their needs are met
- To provide excellent customer service
- To communicate effectively with the team
- To work with team members to achieve goals
- To input and report on the success of allocated tasks
- To arrange and complete appointments throughout South, Central and West Fife
- To complete handy and cleaning work of Greener Kirkcaldy's premises as required
